The Murvi Club can be contacted by e-mail at secretary@murviclub.org.uk. The Murvi Club has a legitimate interest in using the personal data you give to The Murvi Club on the application form for the purpose of communicating with you on matters relating to The Murvi Club and to pass to a distributor to facilitate the posting to your home address material relating to The Murvi Club which cannot be distributed by email or the Murvi Club Hub.

Your personal data will not intentionally be transferred to anyone outside of The Murvi Club and will be deleted from The Murvi Club records two years after your membership of The Murvi Club has terminated. Where appropriate, The Murvi Club may provide limited contact information to an appropriate manufacturer, insolvency practitioner acting in relation to a relevant business, successor organisation or other responsible organisation where this is reasonably necessary to help communicate an important safety or product-recall matter. You have the right to request from The Murvi Club access to and rectification of your personal data. If you feel that your personal data has been misused, you have the right to complain to the Information Commissioners Office.

The Murvi Club protects the privacy of our members.

Any information supplied to The Murvi Club (such as when you apply for membership, set up an account on Murvi Club Hub, pay subscriptions, or apply to join a Murvi Club rally) may be held in paper or electronic format and may also be stored on internet servers such as GoogleDocs or Discourse and may therefore be transferred outside the European Economic Area and to the United States of America for the purposes of processing and maintenance. By submitting your information to us, you expressly consent to this transfer.

You understand that we may transmit information over public networks that may be accessed by third parties, and The Murvi Club will not be liable for any such unauthorised disclosure. Further, you understand that The Murvi Club may, at its discretion, use third-party service providers to administer Web servers and to store such information on back-up disks, and that a service provider may without The Murvi Club's knowledge permit an unauthorised third party to do so on its behalf.
